Glossary of Terms

- PVC:** Polyvinylchloride (PVC) polymer, which is simply basic plastic, and is, by nature, relatively rigid
- Homogeneous:** Vinyl that is of uniform structure, one single layer, and composition throughout, usually consisting of vinyl plastic resins, plasticizers, fillers, pigments, and stabilizers.
- Heterogeneous:** Heterogeneous Vinyl floorcovering is a multi layer product which has a wealth of expressive patterns with unlimited design possibilities reinforced to reduce the cost of maintenance. This allows vinyl flooring to capture the look and feel of any natural flooring material with the added benefits only found in vinyl flooring.
- Calendered:** Having a surface made smooth and glossy especially by pressing between rollers
- Floor Speed:** Dancers, teachers and choreographers will often describe a slippery floor as fast, not ideal for ballet. A fast floor is much appreciated by ballroom and some theatrical styles that require a degree of slide to execute the steps.
- Marbled:** Having a marbled pattern
- Indent:** Order for goods placed often through a local or foreign agent of a foreign supplier under specified conditions of sale, the acceptance of which by the supplier (or the agent) constitutes a contract of sale. Lead time usually 12 weeks
- Lead time:** Period of time taken to manufacture, order or obtain goods
